Local Association Committee Effort a Success

CHERRY HILL, NJ – The Community Outreach Committee from the Burlington Camden County Association of REALTORS® (BCCAR), located in Cherry Hill, in conjunction with D' Anastasio Corporation and the Builder's League of South Jersey, hosted a successful and fun Networking/Fundraising effort which attracted about 200 members and attendees and made over \$3500. The Corporation came by this story of Mr. Davis and his wife and their 8 children, who are facing total homelessness by early July. Mr. Davis is now permanently disabled and cannot work and Mrs. Davis barely makes enough in her jobs to get by.
